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Advocating for Yourself at the Doctor's Office

Nutrition for Adults

It ends with talking about the connection between nutrition and various aspects of health including physical, mental, spiritual, and social health.

The workshop aims to empower individuals with diverse communication options, enhancing their digital accessibility and connectivity.
